The Archdiocese of Atlanta will host the 14th annual Atlanta Catechist Conference on August 22, 2020. The conference theme this year is “Abide in His Love, Hand It On!” An emphasis this year is the kerygmatic and mystagogical catechesis called for by Pope Francis (see his Apostolic Exhortation The Joy of the Gospel [Evangelii Gaudium], nos. 160-168).

Each workshop is 75 minutes. All workshops should include the following criteria:

- Relevance to Catechists and Parish Catechetical Leaders
- Interactive presentation style that includes the opportunity for discussion. Workshop presenters are encouraged to prepare shorter presentations to allow time for idea or faith sharing.
- Reference to kerygmatic and mystagogical catechesis
